



# CITIZENS POLICE ACADEMY

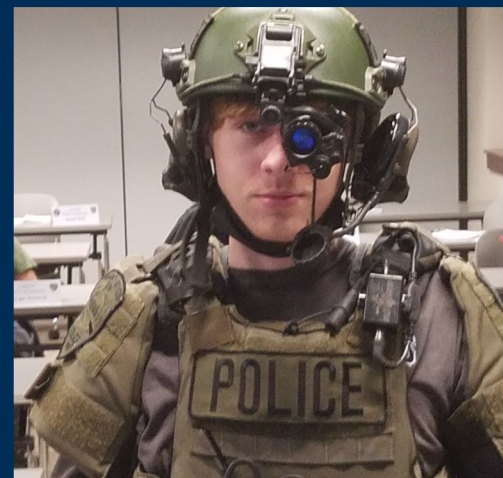
## MARCH 20 - MAY 22, 2023

The Citizens Police Academy is a free, 10-week program designed to give the participants a working knowledge of the **Streamwood Police Department**. It consists of a series of classes, discussions, and exercises held once a week. The course allows a firsthand look at what rules, regulations, and policies the police follow, as well as an overview of the various areas of law enforcement. The objective of the Citizens Police Academy is not to train an individual to be a police officer, but to produce informed citizens who have a clear understanding of services offered by the police department, grow community engagement, and advocate support of police sponsored activities and programs within Streamwood.

The academy will include topics such as patrol/traffic stops, investigations, crime scene/forensics, domestic violence response, how we de-escalate situations and when force is used, crisis intervention, K9 units, social services, and more.

Please complete the application found at [streamwood.org](http://streamwood.org), under Police Department, Community Programs. **Applications are due by March 12, 2023.** Individuals who apply to participate must be at least 18 years of age and live or work in the Village of Streamwood.
