VILLAGE OF STREAMWOOD, ILLINOIS NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX LEVY

I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy for the Village of Streamwood for 2022 will be held on Thursday, November 17, 2022 at 6:30 p.m. at the Village Hall, 301 East Irving Park Road, Streamwood, Illinois.

II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for 2021 were \$11,814,522.

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2022 are \$11,855,349. This represents a 0.3% increase over the previous year.

III. The property taxes extended for debt service in 2021 were \$1,367,377.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service in 2022 are \$1,326,550. This represents a 3.0% decrease from the previous year.

IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2021 were \$13,181,899.

The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2022 are \$13,181,899. This is the same amount as the previous year.
